## **Job Summary:**

The LPN works under the supervision of the Unit Manager/Charge Nurse in assessing, planning, implementing, evaluating, supervising, and documenting the care of all LTC residents; the LTC LPN functions within the policies and standards developed by NDHC.

## **Physical Demands:**

Light medium demands; involves standing, sometimes for prolonged periods; bending, reaching, medium lifting, and pushing residents in wheelchairs and gurneys.

## **Qualifications /Abilities:**

Licensure required by North Dakota Board of Nursing; must have the ability to communicate orally and the ability to read and write; interest and/or previous experience with geriatric residents including chronic care in all age groups.

## **Job Functions:**

Supervises delivery of nursing care to LTC residents; operates equipment in treatment and delivery of resident care; reaches, lifts, carries, and pushes for patient transport, equipment, and other medical equipment; reads and interprets policies and procedures to deliver care and supervise staff; communicates orally on phone, nurse call system, and with patients/residents; able to administer care to long term care patients and residents.

## **Working Conditions:**

Varying light levels in heated/air conditioned and ventilated areas; work done in hallways, Nurses Stations, and Resident rooms.
